

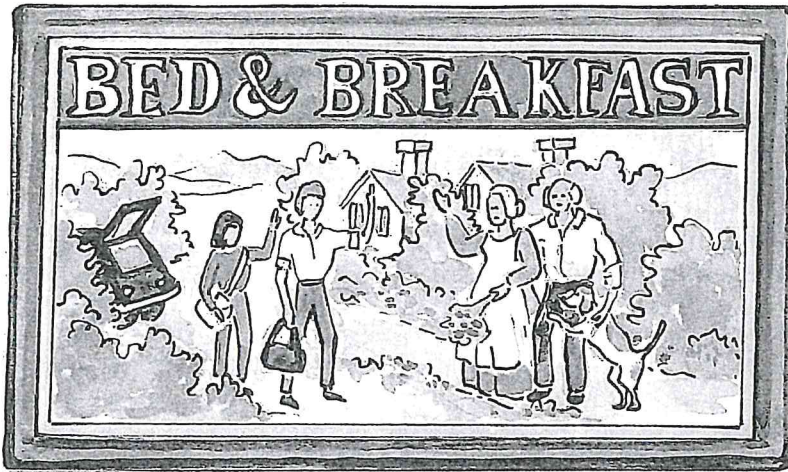

Choosing a place to stay is not always easy. Luckily there are numerous comfortable hotels at reasonable prices in Great Britain.

At the main railway stations there is a hotel service to help you find a room if you have not already booked¹ one. In the hotel you pay per person for bed and breakfast, not for the room as in some other countries. Most hotels offer half-board² (breakfast and evening meal) or full-board (all meals), for those who wish. If you are going to come back late, you should check if there is a night porter³. An interesting old English tradition is the Bible on your bedside table⁴ which you will find in most hotels and guest houses.

If you want to meet native British people in England, Scotland or Wales there is nothing better⁵ than staying at a "Bed and Breakfast". A "B and B" is very reasonable and offers you a good opportunity to practise your English and see the English way of life up close⁶. Sometimes you can have the evening meal with the family for a small extra charge.

If you are touring around, the "B and B" is one of the best ways of spending a night with an English family.
